- **EMS Stroke Case Presentation**
Christy Budy presented a case regarding an 80 year old male who started displaying symptoms around 0800 refused to go to the emergency room; at some point during the night the patient experienced stroke like symptoms. A 12-lead and IV was administered, initial BP was 179/112 and heart rate was 109.

Overall it looks as the paramedics did everything that was asked of them.
- **Update on Stoke Project with SVBGH**
Jay Porter reported that he hasn't been able to get with Mark Day to create a stroke registry by pulling data from VFIB. A meeting is scheduled for the end of August with the stroke coordinator and Porter should have data for the next meeting.
- **Update PI limited budget ideas**
Jay Porter reported that he has spoken with several of our standing committees being that there is a limited budget in which we have to work with; the consensus is to take advantage of Virginia Beach's offer to have their data analysis to determine exactly how much we would need for each project.
