- Welcome/Introductions were made and the July 2016 minutes were approved..
- Old Business
 - Jay Porter addressed the group and notified them that the Trauma Triage Plan has been submitted for approval by the OMD's. The only changes made in the plan was changes in the topic schedules. Once the EMS triage committee comes up with a new hierarchy of where the PI committee's fall within the TEMS system, it will be time to update all of the triage plans. It is time to start thinking about the major rewrite of the trauma triage plan which will take place this year.
- New Business
 - Valeria Mitchell addressed the group and presented the data that was pulled by the VA OEMS staff for data quality.
 - There was an update on the CHKD process of becoming a trauma center by the staff from CHKD.
 - Dr. Kuhn introduced the new trauma coordinator to the group. Her name is Kathy Peterson. Kathy Peterson and Dr. Kuhn relayed the information about CHKD's pursuit for trauma designation. As of 10/01/2016 the necessary nighttime staff will be on hand for any trauma patients that may be brought to CHKD. The Hospital plans to move forward to receive Pediatric Trauma Accreditation as quickly as possible from this

point forward. Dr. Kuhn and Cathy Robertson were invited to attend the December OMD meeting to update all of the PEMS and TEMS physicians on the progress and continued plans to obtain this designation with the timelines associated with the project.

- The next item up for discussion was the next meeting is scheduled to be held during the Virginia Office of EMS annual State Symposium in November. The group was asked whether they would like to keep the meeting scheduled and meet in November or cancel the November meeting due to the large number of people that normally attend the symposium and unable to attend the Trauma Triage Committee meeting.
